Melco Crown Entertainment Builds its MIECF Booth with Recycled Electronic Devices

A call for attention for the increasing e-waste problem in Macau

MACAU – Thursday, March 26, 2015: Melco Crown Entertainment Limited (SEHK: 6883; NASDAQ: MPEL) ("**Melco Crown Entertainment**" or "**the Company**"), a developer, owner and operator of casino gaming and entertainment resort facilities in Asia, participated in the Macao International Environmental Co-operation Forum and Exhibition 2015 (MIECF) as the only prime exhibitor from the green hotel category for the fourth consecutive year. The Company has always been committed to protecting the environment while developing its business; it has also been a strong supporter of the Government's environmental policies and promotion of sustainable development through this prominent exchange platform for industry leaders and the public.

As first runner-up of the Green Booth Award in MIECF 2014, Melco Crown Entertainment has gone one better this year and has built its booth façade with the Company's used and obsolete electronic devices – including electronic chips, computer hard disks and CDs – to help raise awareness of the increasing e-waste problem in Macau. Besides used electronic devices, the construction of the booth also uses other recycled materials from the company, such as wooden wine boxes collected from the restaurants as flooring, and recycled water bottles from its flagship integrated resort, City of Dreams Macau, to build the reception desk. Through its innovative booth design, Melco Crown Entertainment aims to demonstrate its commitment to protecting the environment in which it operates in every respect, and to the sustainable development of Macau.

"Melco Crown Entertainment has deep roots in Macau and the local community. We constantly look for innovative solutions to minimize our impact to the environment while developing our business. We strive to pursue a sustainable future for our society," said **Mr. Lawrence Ho, Co-Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Melco Crown Entertainment.** "We proactively deploy effective measures that help save energy and reduce waste generated from our daily operations; measures which meet even the most stringent international standards for environmental management."



Melco Crown Entertainment's continuous efforts in environment preservation have been recognized both locally and regionally – the Company won the "Excellence Award" in the "Environmental Performance" category at the Business Awards of Macau 2014; the "Best Environmental Responsibility Award" given by Corporate Governance Asia Magazine three years in a row, from 2013 - 2015; and the Company's flagship property, City of Dreams, was the first hotel and integrated resort in Macau to achieve the ISO 14064 Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Emissions Inventories and Verification Standard. The Company's ongoing efforts in implementing advanced green products and solutions to its day-to-day operations include the installation in 2013 of two food waste decomposers at City of Dreams. The decomposers eradicate up to 200kg food waste daily by the use of microorganisms, 73 tons a year. Their use has significantly reduced CO2 emission by 96% per 10 tons of food waste. The residue is used as organic fertilizer at our properties.

RECOGNITIONS & ACHIEVEMENTS

- City of Dreams Macau is the first hotel and integrated resort in Macau to achieve the ISO 14064 Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Emissions Inventories and Verification Standard, accredited by SGS Hong Kong

ENERGY EFFICIENCY

- One of the largest Centralized Cooling Systems in the South China hospitality industry: at least 20-35% more energy-efficient than traditional air-conditioning
- State-of-the-art indoor air purification system conserves energy by reducing the need of outdoor fresh air
- Building Management System monitors air-con temperature 24/7
- Heat created from air-conditioning is converted to heat for tap and shower water
- LED lights for façade are 80% more energy-efficient compared to traditional halogen lamps
- LED lights for interior are 70% more energy-efficient compared to conventional lighting
- Uses the most energy efficient option in the market, T5 tubes, in Heart of House
- Outdoor light fixtures controlled by outdoor photo sensors and time scheduling
- Motion sensors turn off lights at Heart of House when areas are not occupied
- Air Handling Units equipped with Enthalpy Wheel for energy exchange between exhaust air and intake air



- CO & CO2-controlled ventilation in car parks
- Motion-activated escalator operations
- Water-cooled high-efficiency kitchen freezer reduces energy consumption

WATER CONSERVATION

- The House of Dancing Water's sophisticated filtration system and large water storage capacity during maintenance enables pool water at to be used and reused without limit
- Grey water system at Altira Macau recycles treated guestroom sink, shower and bath water as flush water, successfully reducing its freshwater flushing consumption by more than 50%
- Automatic sensors in all faucets within the properties
- · Water feature used as water reserve for fire-fighting
- Rainwater Recovery System stores rainwater for irrigation
- Employee education & contribution in reducing water use when cleaning guestrooms and public areas
 - Basin cleaning with detergent and dry cloth to reduce water use
 - Use mop and bucket to clean public area instead of using high pressure jet
 - Use machines to clean and dry kitchen floor instead of using high pressure jet
 - Use of buckets to water plants instead of a hose

OTHER CONSERVATION

- Since March 2013, Melco Crown Entertainment has been involved, with other resorts in Cotai, in expanding the Lights-Off campaign to once a month in support of Earth Hour
- Since 2013, two biodegradable food waste decomposers have been installed at City of Dreams Macau to decompose and eradicate food waste by the use of microorganisms. The food decomposers handle 200kg of food waste daily, which is equivalent to 73 tons a year, to achieve a significant reduction of CO2 emission (96% per 10 tons of food waste). Residue can be recycled into useful organic fertilizer after six months of operations.
- Our Property Services Department & Housekeeping Department use a paperless work order system to reduce paper consumption
- · Encourage colleagues to use staircase instead of elevator
- Compress all carton boxes collected for recycling
