Melco donates masks to 85 social services facilities managed by Social Welfare Bureau

Part of the Company's efforts to support community groups

Macau, Friday, May 15, 2020 – Earlier this year, Melco Resorts & Entertainment announced a further donation of [500,000 surgical masks](#) to support the government's fight against Coronavirus. 200,000 such masks have since been donated directly to 85 social services facilities managed by Social Welfare Bureau (IAS) to benefit local community groups such as the elderly, and people with rehabilitation and special needs.

A mask donation ceremony was held today at Morpheus, City of Dreams as teams of [Melco colleagues were also being deployed en masse to support the community](#) as part of the Company's 'Simple Acts of Kindness' philosophy. The Company is currently operating a temporary casino, the first casino in the Republic of Cyprus, and four satellite casinos ("Cyprus Casinos"). Upon the opening of City of Dreams Mediterranean, the Company will also continue to operate the four satellite casinos while operation of the temporary casino will cease.
