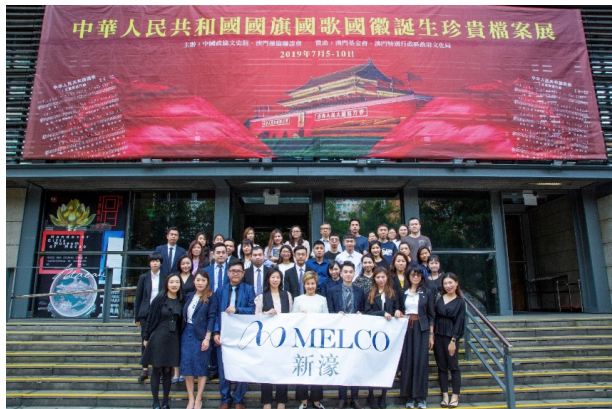
Melco representatives visit exhibition showcasing documents on the national flag, national anthem and national emblem
